**Instructions for Authors Regarding Preparation of Manuscripts**

**Abstract**

**Abstract** The abstract, that must also include the contacts, must not exceed one page. It can include, in grey scale, pictures, diagrams, or graphs. Abstracts exceeding one page will be returned for resubmission.

In “Contact” include the name of the corresponding author, his email and the name of the Institution. If there are authors without emails, please write other contact (fax, or telephone number, or full address).

The text should be delivered by in MS WORD (.doc).

**Publications** The abstract will be published in the Book of Abstracts, which will be distributed at the Symposium to all participants.

**Full Paper**

**Full paper** The full paper shall not exceed 10 pages including abstract, pictures, diagrams, references and appendices. The text should be delivered in MS WORD (.doc) and PDF.

Bibliographical references should follow the Harvard referencing system. Full citations are collected in alphabetical order under the "References" heading at the end of the paper. The following sequence and punctuation should be used: Author's surname, author's initials, year of publication, title of reference article, name of book or journal (or other), volume number, page numbers, publisher, city:
